



E-MEDIVIP:

E-LEARNING PLATFORM FOR MEDICAL INFORMATICS TO IMPROVE VOCATIONAL AND ICT PRACTICE

The **E-MEDIVIP**, an “**e-Learning platform for Medical Informatics to improve Vocational and ICT Skills**” is an **ERASMUS+** project jointly led by the Bilecik Seyh Edebali and the Sakarya Universities in Turkey, within the framework of the Strategic Partnerships Program (Key Action 2 – Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices). The project is supported by the European Commission and the Turkish National Agency (Part of the Ministry of European Affairs) and has the following objectives:

- 5 different open-source e-education modules for the enhancement of medical ICT skills of medical staff of all levels and background (secondary education, undergraduate, bachelor’s degree, post graduate degree).
- Development of education-in-distance material addressing up-to-date issues, according to the results obtained through questionnaires provided to medical staff, from the different countries represented in the project.
- Evaluation of training modules in pilot groups according to the EQAVET vocational education criteria, before defining their final version.
- Educational modules available as open source, after being translated into Turkish, English, Spanish (only some modules), and German.
- Interactive and extensive contents as open-source, to meet needs in terms of lifelong learning.

The CIBER-BBN is participating in the E-MEDIVIP project with **Dr. Margarita Juliá**, senior researcher with the group of Biomedical Applications of Nuclear Magnetic Resonance led by Prof. Carles Arús at the **University Autònoma of Barcelona**.
