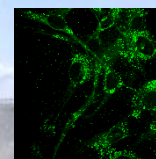
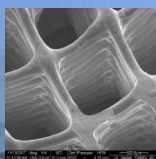


13th International Symposium on Frontiers in Biomedical Polymers
