
MINUTES OF THE AWARD RESOLUTION

Julio San Román Award 2026

On the 22nd of July, the Steering Committee met to review the assessment carried out by the Evaluation Committee of the Julio San Román Award 2026 and to ratify its resolution, which is hereby recorded.

1. THE AWARD

The CIBER-BBN Julio San Román Award 2026 recognizes and encourages outstanding research carried out by young researchers within CIBER-BBN in the fields of Bioengineering, Biomaterials and Nanomedicine, with particular emphasis on contributions of strong international impact and collaborative character.

The award consists of a certificate of recognition, an economic award of €2,000 allocated to a cost centre supporting the awardee's research, full coverage of travel and accommodation expenses to attend the Annual CIBER-BBN Meeting (El Escorial, 19–20 November 2026), and an invitation to present the awarded research during said conference.

2. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

The candidatures received before the deadline of 31 May 2026 were evaluated in accordance with the selection criteria established in the call: Innovation and Originality (15%), Scientific Excellence (30%), Impact and Relevance (15%), Interdisciplinary Collaboration (30%) and Practical and Translational Potential (10%).

3. RESOLUTION

Having examined and discussed the merits of all eligible candidatures, the Evaluation Committee unanimously agrees to grant the CIBER-BBN Julio San Román Award 2026 to:
